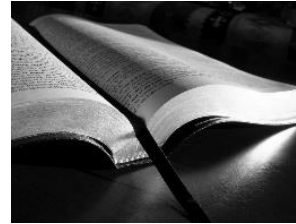

July 2017 - From the Pastor

Have you ever thought of all the things you sign your name to; important things like credit card purchases, documents for buying a car, or contracts for purchasing a home. Then there are those simple things that need your signature, things like a get well note, or a thank you or birthday card. Your name has a specific place on that legal document. Since you are the sender, it is only your name that ends up on the inside of that card. The place and presence of your name brought back to mind for me a Scripture in *Isaiah 49:15-16*, “*Can a woman forget her nursing child and have no compassion on the son of her womb? Even these may forget, but I will not forget you. **Behold, I have inscribed you on the palm of My hands...***” (my emphasis). How about that for a place for your name to be found-in the hand of God! Now your name is not written on His hand because He forgets. Quite the contrary-He doesn't miss a thing. Our God does not suffer memory loss. So why write our name down you may ask? This is just a visible illustration to remind us how connected our life is and always will be to God. It was Charles Spurgeon who said of God, “*He has linked His people with His life....to tear you away would be to destroy Him.*” As a believer your name will never be removed or erased. This promise will not be discarded or fade away to be forgotten over time. You are eternally bound to the One who loves you, and purchased you with the blood of His one and only Son, Jesus Christ! You have His Word on it-in writing!
