If you would like to place flowers in sanctuary in the New Year, the **2022 Flower Calendar** is located on the bulletin board near the office/nursery.

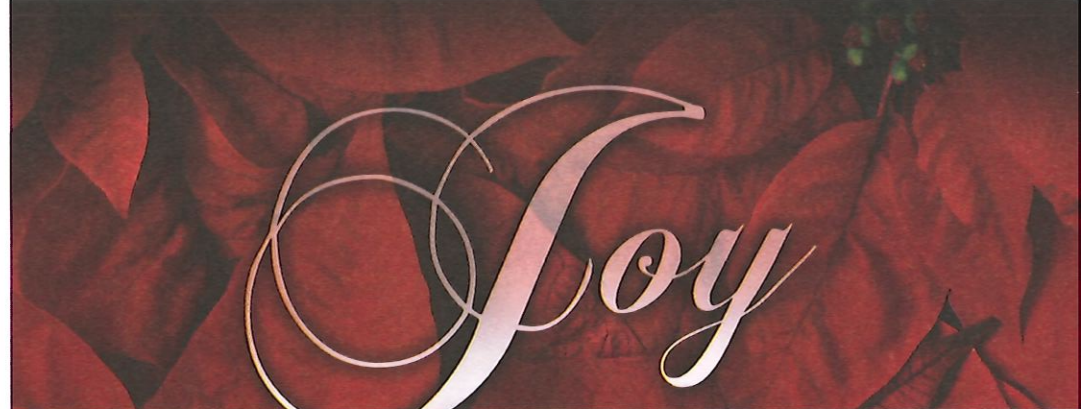
