Psalm 141:3-4 says, "Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips. Do not incline my heart to any evil thing, to practice the deeds of wickedness with men who do

iniquity; and do not let me eat of their delicacies." This was a part of a prayer that David offered for his sanctification and protection (stop and grab your Bible and read all ten verses). Have you ever thought about beginning your prayer time with such a request? David's plea, at the outset of his prayer, was for God, first, to guard his lips. He wanted the Lord to control his tongue so that He would not say anything that would offend God or would indict himself. Don't let my words in prayer be inappropriate. Then he turns, second, to the issue of his heart. He knows how easily the heart can imagine terrible things. Watch the progression: a heart of evil thoughts can quickly if not checked lead to actions of wickedness. At that point my life, in thought and in action, looks no different from those who make iniquity their lifestyle. David wants his heart, the fountain of life, to be pure. For out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks. Lord, draw me close and make me clean. Take charge over my heart and watch the door of my lips. Cause my time in the prayer closet to be humble, gracious, and fruitful.
