 - 162 seniors 60+

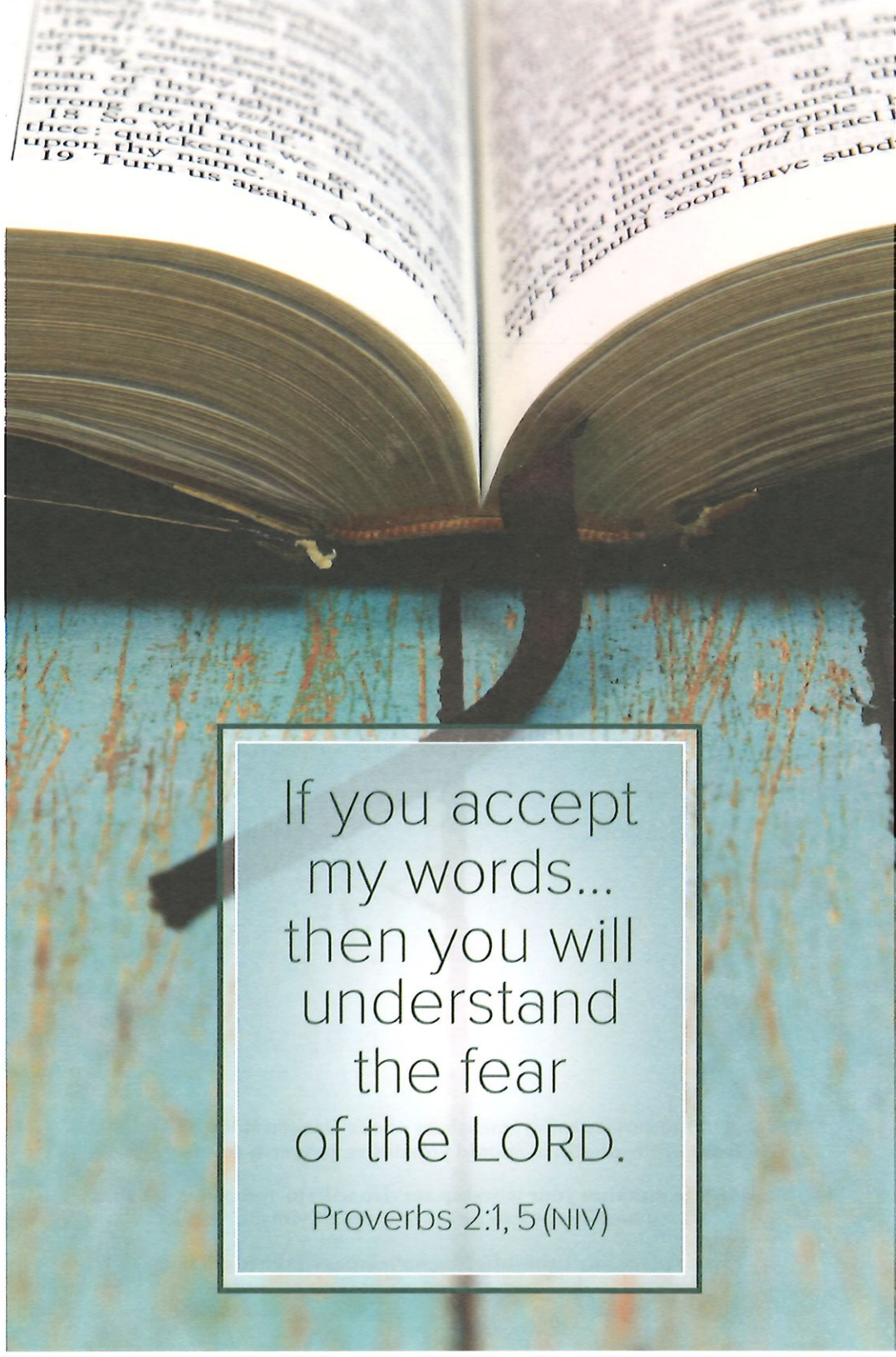
Our next event will be on March 7th and the signup sheet is located on the board in the hallway behind the sanctuary.
