We took a break last month but now I would like to get back to our study in the "Lord's Prayer," found in Matthew 6:5-14. Verse nine (9), says, "Pray, then, in this

way: Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name." Since we have been adopted into the family of God through faith in His Son, the Lord Jesus, we can now approach this great God as "Our Father." What a privilege we have, and one that we should never take for granted. As we approach the One who is our heavenly Father, Jesus teaches us to begin with three petitions that cause us to focus on Him, not us! The first one, in verse 9, says to hallow, or as one translation puts it, to "honor as holy," our heavenly Father. The idea is as we pray, we admire, esteem, honor, reverence, treasure, and value God's name above everything else. As you begin prayer, substitute the word hallow with any one of these previous terms. What you are saying to God is that I value You and Your Name as holy. This helps us to see God as infinitely unique, pure, undefiled, and righteous. Don't miss the point here: Jesus' first request is not for personal needs to be met, but that God's glory and holiness be known and loved as it deserves. What a great way to begin your prayer time.
