The **April** newsletter is available on all the entrance tables.

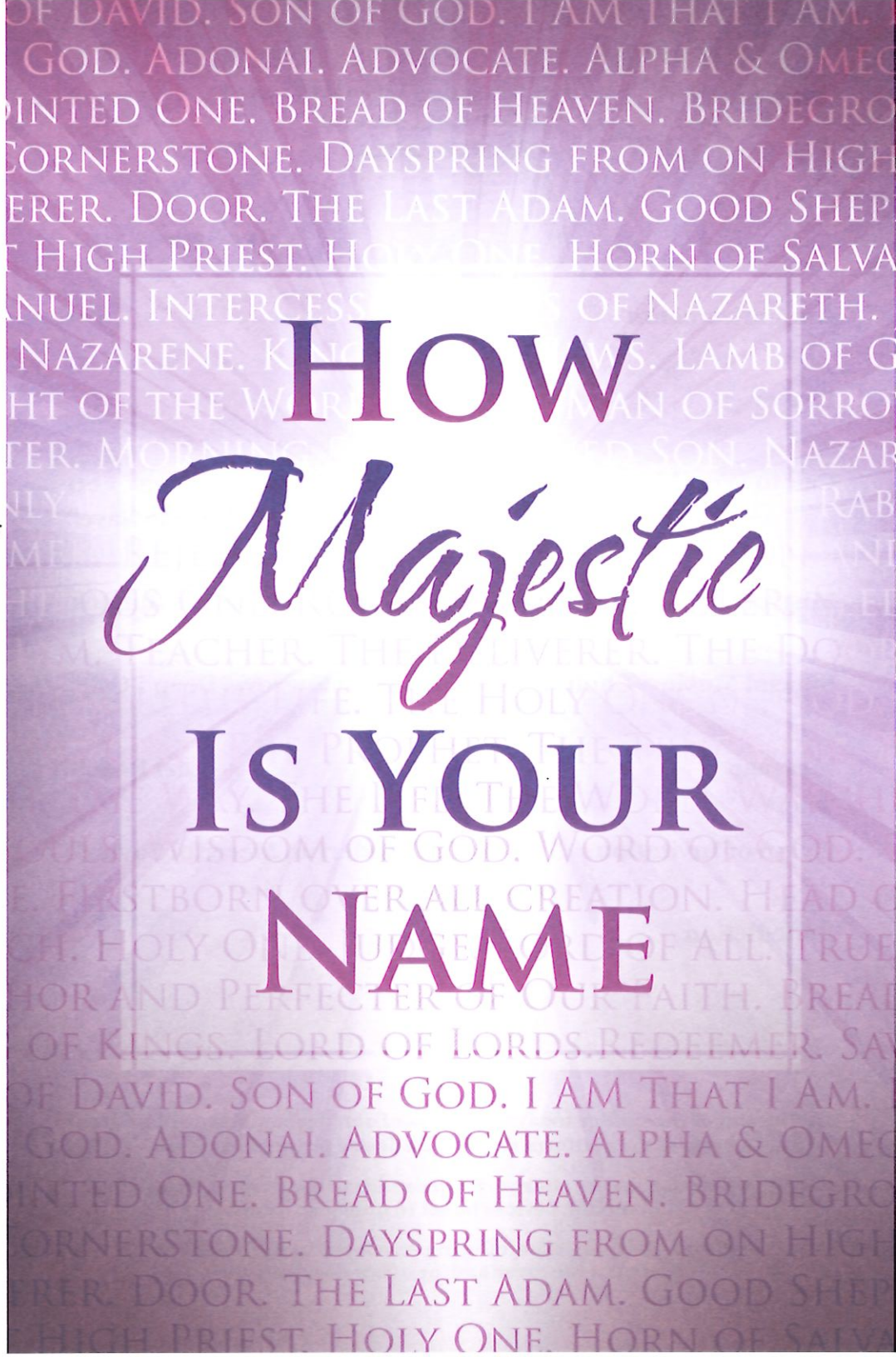
