

In our review of the "Lord's Prayer," or better yet, "The Prayer our Lord taught His Disciples to Pray," we come to verses 11-13 (take a moment to read these verses). This model prayer now shifts its focus. It

moves from our heavenly Father to us and our needs. Sometimes well-meaning people will tell you we should never pray "I," "me," or "we" prayers, because that means we have become man-centered rather than Godcentered. Now, I'll be the first to admit (cause I've done it) that too many of our prayers focus more on us than God. However, our gracious and loving heavenly Father delights in our coming into His presence, pouring out our heart and sharing our needs. What did you read in verses 11-13? That we ask for three things: our daily needs, for forgiveness of our sins, for deliverance and rescue from the evil one, Satan himself. This text sends a clear and unmistakable message: we are merely creatures; God is the Creator. We are needy; God is the provider. Our lives are frail, fragile, and wholly dependent on the goodness of God. Warren Wiersbe is right when he said, "Satan wants to convince us that prayer is a waste of time, but the Word of God and our own Christian experience assures us that prayer is a key to God's treasury of grace." Next month we begin our study of each of these three requests. In the meantime, review the following Scriptures. They each teach us the necessity of and goal of our praying. (Jeremiah 33:3; Matthew 7:7-8; Hebrews 4:16; Philippians 4:6-7; *James 4:8)*
