# **JULY 2025 NEWSLETTER**



As we saw last month, we are taught in the Lord's Prayer to petition God for forgiveness of our debts (sins). I have said many times that 1 John 1:9 ought to be highlighted in our Bibles (take a

moment and go read that portion of Scripture and you will see why we must run to this passage constantly!). In Matthew 6:12, Jesus also teaches us to pray that God forgive us in the same way that we forgive those who have sinned against us. What Jesus is forcefully teaching here is that when we experience God's forgiveness, we are fundamentally transformed into forgiving people. In Ephesians 4:32, Paul says, "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other just as God in Christ also has forgiven you." Corporately, few things shortcircuit the power of the church as conflicts and a spirit of unforgiveness. Psalm 66:18 is clear, "If I regard wickedness (or iniquity) in my heart, the Lord will not hear." Let that scripture sink in for a moment. God cannot work freely among those who carry grudges and harbor resentments. Consider this from Ken Hemphill, "When we remain unforgiving toward others who have wronged us, we have not taken seriously the enormity of our sin and the cost that Christ has incurred to provide our forgiveness. When we refuse to forgive, we are the ones held captive (my emphasis). Those who know the forgiveness of sins, forgive others. May the God of all grace help us to do so.
