

If I could offer you a verse of Scripture to set the course for your daily walk with the Lord in 2026, it would be the following: “Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, dwell (or think) on these things.” (Philippians 4:8). When Paul said to dwell or to think, he wasn’t using a term for a casual frame of mind. He used a word that meant “to take into account carefully,” “to calculate.” Paul was urging his readers (and us) to be careful about the things you dwell upon. Be intentional. Think about what is true, not false; honorable, not dishonorable; right or just, not unjust; pure, not impure; lovely, not repulsive; good reputation, or commendable, not what is wrong. Come back to this verse frequently throughout the year. Let these virtues mark your life. Be a Godly example before others. People are watching you. May they see by how you live, what you say, and the things you value, that you are a person they can emulate. As Christians, what we think matters and it matters more than we think.
